## Manager's Corner

As much as we enjoy the summer weather, we really could use some rain to help the lawns and the water supply systems in many NH communities. At this time of year, the children are out of school and many families take some special time to vacation together or just to spend more time together as a family. We hope that you enjoy your time this summer!

**Prize Homesite Award** - Exceptional landscaping has always been an integral part of a Jensen's Residential Community. Many residents go above and beyond what is expected to enhance their yards. The "Prize Home site Award" is intended to award the homeowner(s) whose yard stands out above all the rest. The award is one month's lot rental fee. At Crestwood, two winners will be picked prior to July 12, 2018. Criteria used in selecting the best home site are as follows; colorful flowers and shrubs, sharp edging around beds with mulch, pine straw, stone, etc., eye catching arrangements, exceedingly well-maintained grass, and an attractive home and utility building. Let's try to make this decision as difficult as possible for the judges!

**Shrub Trimming** - The annual trimming of all shrubs in the community will begin shortly. If you do not want the Jensen staff or our subcontractors to trim the shrubs on your home site, please drop a note off at the office. Just because you asked last year doesn't mean you don't need to write this year. If the shrubs are overgrown we may want to discuss the looks of the home site with you. We'd also be happy to remove any old and worn out shrubs.

**Water Use** - We track the amount of water used on almost a daily basis. It is amazing how much the usage rises during the summer months. During periods of no rain it is typical to have the water use *triple* as resident's water their lawns or use water for other purposes. Also, the sewer charges go up as a proportion of the water bill. Obviously, this adds up to a significantly higher bill. Please be conservative when you're using this costly and precious resource.

**Jensen's Sales and Referrals** - We currently have a limited number of homes listed for resale and are in contact daily with potential buyers about relocating to Crestwood. Please remember the Jensen Referral fee plan. If you refer someone to us and they purchase a new home from Jensen's then you will receive a referral fee equal to two months lot rent. If they purchase a brokered home through Jensen's you receive one month's rent. We will be adding another one or two spec. new homes in the coming months, why not refer a friend and get the two months' rent paid directly to you! Easy money!
